MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dewayne Birchfield at 7:00pm.

ROLL CALL

Upon Roll Call, the following Board members were PRESENT: Delmar Davis, Derek Doehler, Linda Black, Tina Baker and Dewayne Birchfield.

Thereupon, Mayor Dewayne Burchfield declared the presence of a quorum.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Alderman Black made a motion to adopt the December 9, 2025 Board Meeting Agenda. The motion was seconded by Alderman Doehler.

Upon Voice Vote, the motion PASSED 5/0.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Alderman Black made the motion that the November 11, 2025 Board Meeting Minutes be accepted and approved as written. The motion was seconded by Alderman Doehler.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENTS

Alderman Black inquired about opening a savings or investment account for the City. Mayor Birchfield informed that he does have paperwork to do so.

Alderman Doehler thanked Stacy O'Neil and volunteers for their hard work on the Christmas Parade.

Mayor Birchfield informed that TASS will begin billing the Town of Greenback monthly for its contribution to the sewer project.

BOARD COMMENTS

OLD BUSINESS

- A. Mayor Birchfield informed that 6869 Morganton Rd, previously referred to as the old PPAWS building, has been leased.
- B. In consideration of safety and liability as pointed out by the Town's insurance provider, as well as damage already incurred from frequent traffic on a residential road, the second reading of Ordinance 25-5 prohibiting vehicles with a gross weight over 26,000 pounds on Hutton Road was completed. Alderman Doehler made a motion to accept Ordinance 25-5 prohibiting vehicles over 26,000lbs on Hutton Road. Alderman Baker seconded the motion.

Upon roll call the following Board members voted AYE; Doehler, Baker, Black, Davis, Birchfield.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Discussion of a resolution appointing the Public Safety Director to formally serve as Assistant to the Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance, Office of the State Fire Marshal for matters arising within the boundaries of the Town of Greenback.
